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Method of Works/Safe System of Works	Risks/Hazards/Controls/Notes
Planning 1. Collect equipment and PPE from storage. 2. Visually inspect equipment and PPE prior to commencing work, 3. Any faulty or damaged equipment will be reported to line manager for action. 4. Equipment will be marked with a 'Do not use' sticker until repaired, replaced or removed. 5. Any damaged PPE will be immediately replaced. 6. Ensure the radio/ phone communication is agreed with line manager/ colleague or security.	1. Hearing loss due to damaged or incorrect use of hearing protection – ensure operative is fully conversant in the correct use and aware to replace it if damaged during the task.

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7. Check the radio or phone to ensure its fully charged and functioning correctly. 8. Where possible, activate vibrate mode for the duration of work in noisy environment. Safe Method of Work 1. Carry out the task as per task specific method statement. 2. Where equipment used generates a high level of noise, ensure you are wearing ear protection. 3. When entering a plant room with a safety signs listing hearing protection required you must ensure it is being worn for the duration of the work carried out in that area. 4. Ensure personal protection equipment is replaced if damaged during the task. Completion 1. Return equipment and PPE to the storage area. 2. Visually inspect the equipment for any damages that might have occurred during the task. 3. Inspect PPE for damages and replace if required.	
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Environmental Impacts	Ensure that all waste is disposed of in accordance with the site procedures
Emergency Arrangements	If the task includes any periods of Lone Working, follow the ABM Lone Working Procedure First aid available from the security team. 2-way radio provided to staff while at work.
